As part of preparing for the disaster season, producers are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries' <u>Natural Disaster Impact Survey</u>. The survey has been designed to support producers who have experienced losses or damage to their property during a disaster event. The information collected through the survey helps the Queensland Government determine the appropriate level of disaster recovery assistance to provide under jointly funded Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Producers can also complete the survey via the Department of Agricultural and Fisheries' <u>natural disaster ehub</u> during and after a natural disaster event. It's easy to use and takes less than five minutes to complete. Check it out today!
