Doomadgee is approximately 100km North West of Burketown and 130km East of the Northern Territory Border. It is 630km by road to Mt Isa and 1035km west of Cairns. Doomadgee has daily Rex flights, Police Station, School (Prep to Year 10), Hospital, Bakery, Supermarket and Service Station.

The successful applicant will be expected to deliver quality performance in the role which includes overall responsibility for administration, governance and finance and postal agency services. It is essential that the successful applicant can maintain positive working relationships in a small community and manage continuous improvement.
