



DOOMADGEE WATER CONSERVATION

Until further notice the following measures need to be observed due to the dry conditions and to conserve our remaining water reserves.

- Hand held hoses for watering gardens only is limited to a maximum of 30 minutes on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.
- Vehicles are to be cleaned by pressure cleaners, bucket, sponge and restricted to grassed areas.
- Restricted washing of paths and driveways.
- Restricted refilling of inflatable and other back yard swimming pools.

Some water saving tips;

- Make sure that all taps are turned off and not dripping.
- Fix or report leaking taps and toilets.
- Reduce shower time.
- Keep bottled water in the fridge instead of running water until it becomes cold.
- Make sure your dishwasher and washing machines are full to maximise water usage or change the settings to suit the load.
