There are a range of casual roles available across Queensland, and you can work before, after or on election day.

All temporary election staff are paid and receive training and support.

Eligibility

To work at an election you must:

- be on the electoral roll (you can check your enrolment on the [Australian Electoral Commission](http://www.aec.gov.au) website)
- be at least 16 years-old (if you are 16- or 17 you must be provisionally enrolled on the electoral roll)
- have a unique email address (i.e. two people cannot apply using the same email address)
- successfully complete mandatory training
- adhere to the ECQ's policies and the [Terms and Conditions of Employment](#).
