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Planning in Doomadgee

Doomadgee Aboriginal Shire Council, like other councils throughout the State, is responsible for ensuring development that occurs within the local government area is conducted in a manner that meets community expectations and relevant standards.

Ultimately Council's responsibility in the planning process is to ensure that the strong community's quality of life, of family ties, leadership and culture are maintained together with bonds to ancestral heritage, progressive vision for the future and tuned to Doomadgee's natural settings with respect for culture and country.

What is Planning Scheme?

A planning scheme is a legal document prepared under State Planning Legislation with a specific purpose of guiding and regulating the development of land. A Planning Scheme comprises a set of rules and supporting maps and policies that manage and guide the way land, buildings and structures can be used and development within a local government area. It is a Plan. It is the document that aims to ensure that there is residential areas, industrial areas and commercial land and that all three areas are located so that they compliment each other and reduce any conflicts for uses.

Doomadgee Aboriginal Shire Council Planning Scheme 2014

The Doomadgee Planning Scheme 2014 (Planning Scheme) came into effect 7 November 2014 and with amendments on 18 April 2019 which came into effect 24 May 2019.

The Planning Scheme provides up to date rules for managing the built environment and guide decision making in relation to integrated land use and any new development.

The Doomadgee Shire Planning Scheme 2014 applies to the planning scheme of Doomadgee Aboriginal Shire Council and includes all premises, roads, internal waterways, local government tidal areas and interrelates with surrounding local government areas.
